2023 Spousal Impoverishment Standards

Effective January 1, 2023, the Medicaid spousal impoverishment standards will be as follows:

Combined Resource Standard	\$ 150,620.00*
Community Spouse Protected Resource Amount	\$ 148,620.00*
Community Spouse Maintenance Income Allowance	*\$3,715.50 (*PNA for ICWP also)

2023 Excess Home Limit

Effective January 1, 2023, the excess home equity limit will be \$688,000.00.
