

SECTION 6002 – A/N/E MDT Attendance

<p><b>SUMMARY STATEMENT:</b></p>	<p>Adult Protective Services (APS) will make every effort to attend all scheduled Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Multidisciplinary Team (A/N/E MDT) meetings.</p>
<p><b>BASIC CONSIDERATIONS</b></p>	<p>In accordance with O.C.G.A §30-5-11(c)(1) “Each Adult Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Multidisciplinary Team shall meet regularly, as determined by the district attorney or his or her designee; provided however, that meetings shall be held at least semiannually”.</p>
<p><b>PROCEDURES</b></p> <p><b>Attendance Tracking</b></p>	<p>Whenever possible, for the purpose of consistency and continuity, the designated APS representative to the A/N/E MDT shall attend all scheduled meetings. When the designated A/N/E MDT representative is unavailable a substitute APS representative shall be in attendance.</p> <p>Meeting attendance shall be tracked on the Activity Log located in the Division of Aging Services electronic data system. <u>Each staff person</u> who attends a A/N/E MDT shall record the following A/N/E MDT details:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Name;</li> <li>• Focus;</li> <li>• Location;</li> <li>• Date;</li> <li>• Time spent; and</li> <li>• Number of people in attendance</li> </ul>
