2026 Spousal Impoverishment Standards

Effective January 1, 2026, the Medicaid Spousal Impoverishment Standards will be as follows:

Combined Resource Standard: \$164,660.00

Community Spouse Protected Resource Amount: \$162,660.00

Community Spouse Maintenance Income Allowance/Maximum Monthly Maintenance Needs Allowance: \$4,066.50 (PNA for ICWP also)

2026 Excess Home Limit

Effective January 1, 2026, the excess home equity limit will be \$752,000.00.
